Courtney Mauer came to Iowa City Ambulatory Surgical Center by the recommendation of Dr. Benjamin MacLennan to repair herniated discs in her spine.

In the beginning, Courtney was experiencing unexplained back pain. "I was having back pain that was noticeable, yet bearable. As time progressed, so did the pain in my lower back. First, I went to my family practitioner. I was told that I had sciatica and that eventually this pain would go away. I let my pain continue for almost a year before I went to see a specialist (Dr. MacLennan) at Steindler Orthopedic Clinic," she said. "The pain was so bad that I could barely stand up straight or walk normally. It was hard to do everyday tasks because I was in so much pain. All I could do was lay down and even then, there were some positions that were hard to handle. To stand up, I had to lean against something or the shooting pain was too much."

Before Courtney went to see Dr. MacLennan, she had tried other alternatives to ease her pain. "I tried going to the chiropractor to see if I just needed to have an adjustment. I had also tried physical therapy. I even tried epidural steroid injections twice, but they didn't seemed to be working. I was taking a great deal of ibuprofen, just to get through the day."

"Dr. MacLennan went over everything with me and what he would be doing during the surgery. He would remove part of the discs that were bulging then he would widen a spot so my sciatic nerve wasn't being pinched."
